

# LGBTIQ+ STUDIES CERTIFICATE

The undergraduate certificate in LGBTIQ+ Studies is a twelve-credit, interdisciplinary program that groups together courses with content focusing on gender and sexual diversity with a goal of preparing students for their future careers by providing a strong grounding in diversity and equity issues around gender and sexuality. The certificate is housed in the Women's, Gender, and Sexuality Studies Program.
