DOCTOR OF PHILOSOPHY - SPEECH, LANGUAGE, AND HEARING SCIENCES

Degree Specific Credits: 60

Required Cumulative GPA: 3.0

- The program is made up of a combination of 60 credits of coursework and professional products courses, the preliminary comprehensive competency exam, and a dissertation.
- Students must pass a preliminary comprehensive competency exam that includes disciplinary knowledge, a critique of a research manuscript, and design of an experimental research study.
- In addition, students complete professional products courses in areas critical for the success of faculty or professionals in the speech, language, and hearing sciences that include the following:
 - research,
 - conference presentation,
 - writing for publication,
 - systematic review of research literature,
 - grant writing,
 - college teaching, and/or
 - supervision.
- Following the successful completion of coursework, the preliminary comprehensive competency exam, and professional products courses, students complete a directed research dissertation experience that contributes to the advancement of the field of speech, language, and hearing sciences.
- Full-time students entering with their completed masters' degree in an area related to speech, language, and hearing sciences can complete the PhD in 3-4 years.
